## Eligibility

To participate, caregivers must live in the City of Boston or provide care to a Boston resident. In addition, care recipients must be at least 60 years of age unless they have been diagnosed with Alzheimer's Disease or related dementia. In that case, there is no age restriction. Our experienced staff will answer your questions and assist with the application process.



### Services and Supports

Boston Senior Home Care offers a wide range of services and supports to all caregivers at no charge, including:

#### Individual Assessments

- Needs assessment
- In-home care planning
- Long-distance caregiving

#### Personal and Family Support Services

- Adult Day Health and companion services
- In-home services and supports
- Caregiver support group
- Caregiving education and training
- Referrals to elder law offices for help with estate planning and legal documents; and to behavioral health specialists for mental health or substance use disorders
- Information and referrals to community resources
- Education and training on caring for an older adult at home, including dementia, falls prevention, cognitive health, and social engagement
- Scholarships for after-school programs, assistive technology and adaptive equipment
